Coach Instructions

- Team Sign (to be used in the On Deck Area during Head-to-Head Relays)
- Championship Checklist; Schedule of Events
- WSSA Sport Stacking Rule Book; Judges Tips and Procedures

Gather your Team

- Enter the gym and find a place for your team to sit down. Look for the section that corresponds to your teams division.
- Sit in Rows 4 and above of your Age Division. (*NOTE: Spectators only in Rows 1-3*) Stackers may warm-up at the On Deck Tables on the gym floor and the Warm-Up Tables outside the gym, **but not at the Competition Tables.**

9:45-10:00 am Opening Ceremonies

Please move up into the stands and enjoy the ceremonies.

10:00-11:00 am Prelims Individual, Doubles – All Divisions

- **DO NOT LOSE** the time sheets – they are your official time sheets. These have been pre-printed with the Stacker's name, division and school. If this information is incorrect, please mark up the time sheet with corrections.
- Stackers line up at the On Deck Tables. Once they start their warm-up at On Deck Table they are committed to go to the Competition Table next. **PRELIMS MAY BE DONE AT ANY DIVISION.**
- Each Stacker gives their Prelim Time Sheet and "My Best Times" Sheet to the Judge at the Competition Table.
- The Judge will keep the Prelim Time Sheet and return the "My Best Times" Sheet to the Stacker.
- Have your team complete **all** Individual Prelim events during this time.

11:00-11:30 am Timed 3-6-3 Prelims – All Divisions

- Same procedure as individual prelims.

11:30 am-2:00 pm Head-to-Head 3-6-3 Team Relays (3-3-3 for 6U)

- Relay Managers will introduce themselves and call down all Coaches for a brief pre-tournament meeting. Take roll and hand out brackets.
- First teams called down to Competition Tables.
- Subsequent teams will be called to the "On Deck Tables" where they can warm up.
- Coach hold up your Team Sign (in packet). **GIVE THE SIGN TO THE JUDGE BEFORE EACH MATCH.**
- Shake hands, high fives, etc. before and after each match. Each match is best 2 out of 3.
- Return to your seats in the stands between matches.
- Top 3 teams are awarded immediately after final match. If you're one of these teams **DO NOT LEAVE** until you've received your awards.
- Teams eliminated should go complete all Prelims if they haven't already done so.

3:00 p.m.	Cycle Age Division Finals (top 5 in each)

4:15 p.m.	Timed 3-6-3 Age Division Finals (top 3)

4:30 pm Overall Awards Presentation (Champions Crowned!)

** All "Potential" WSSA records will need to be verified post-tournament) **
